SUBJECT: Multiple Stamped Copies

Due to the implementation of Electronic Case Filing (ECF), the clerk's office will no longer process multiple stamped copies of documents. For a limited time, the court will date stamp **one** copy of the document with either a "Filed" or "Received" stamp. If the filing is via the United States Postal Service or other mail delivery service, a metered or other postage paid self-addressed envelope large enough to accommodate the return copy must be provided. The clerk's office will eventually cease to return any copies in the near future. (The only possible exception would be copies for *pro se* debtors).

Attorneys and creditors are strongly encouraged to register for ECF training in order to prepare for full implementation of ECF.
