To provide for an equitable distribution of the total caseload in the Dallas and Fort Worth Divisions, effective September 19, 2001, all newly filed cases will be assigned by random draw as follows:


<u>Dallas Division</u>		<u>Fort Worth Division</u>	
Robert C. McGuire	25%	Barbara J. Houser	40%
Steven A. Felsenthal	30%	Dennis Michael Lynn	60%
Barbara J. Houser	15%		
Harold C. Abramson	30%		

In the Dallas Division, pending cases will not be reassigned; and until Judge Houser's total pending caseload of Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 cases reaches 15% of the total cases pending under each of those chapters, she will be assigned 30% of all newly filed cases under each chapter and the Chapter 7 and 13 draw will be reduced by 9% for Judge McGuire and 3% for Judges Felsenthal and Abramson.

In the Fort Worth Division, pending Chapter 11 cases will not be reassigned; and until Judge Lynn's pending Chapter 11 caseload reaches 60% of the total Chapter 11 cases filed the previous twelve (12) months, he will receive 75% of all newly filed Chapter 11 cases.

Effective September 24, 2001, 60% of the pending Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 cases and all pending Chapter 12 cases in the Fort Worth Division, along with any associated adversary proceedings, will be randomly reassigned to Judge Lynn.
