

CM/ECF UPDATES AND CHANGES

INDIVIDUAL SCHEDULE SELECTION

The *Schedules* event [**Bankruptcy → Schedules/Statements/New Case Deficiencies → Schedules**] has been modified to allow you to select schedules (see fig. 1) using individual check boxes.





SCHEDULES EVENT

An error message has been added to the *Schedules* event [**Bankruptcy → Schedules/Statements/New Case Deficiencies → Schedules**]. When you select the Schedules D, E, F radio button (see fig. 3, next page) and indicate that you are adding a creditor (see fig. 4, next page), you **MUST** enter the creditor's information in the box provided (see fig. 5, next page).



NOTICE OF NEW LEAD COUNSEL

The *Notice of new lead counsel within firm* event [**Bankruptcy** → **Notices** → **Notice of new lead counsel within firm**] event has been modified to allow you to add the new attorney to the case.

After selecting the attorney to be terminated from the case (see fig. 7), the event will allow you to search for the attorney to be added to the case (see fig. 8).





WHO WILL THIS CHANGE AFFECT? CM/ECF users filing a Notice of new lead counsel within firm

JURY DEMAND

We have modified the *Jury demand* event [**Adversary → Miscellaneous → Jury demand**] to allow you to link to an amended complaint. Previously, the event only allowed you to link to the original complaint.

WHO WILL THIS CHANGE AFFECT? CM/ECF users filing jury demand

AMENDED PETITION

We have modified the *Amended petition* event [**Bankruptcy → Miscellaneous → Amended petition**] to allow you to link to a previously filed involuntary petition. Previously, the event only allowed you to link to voluntary petitions, and amendments to involuntary petitions were filed using the *Notice (generic)* event.

WHO WILL THIS CHANGE AFFECT? CM/ECF users filing an amended involuntary petition

FILE NEW ADVERSARY CASE EVENT

We have added a warning to the *File a New Adversary Case* event reminding you that ALL plaintiffs and defendants listed on the complaint must be added in CM/ECF (see fig. 11).


