Motion to Quash

The event [**Bankruptcy > Motions/Applications > Quash**] and [**Adversary > Motions > Quash**] has been modified to allow optional linkage to an existing document (see Figure 1). Often motions to quash are filed relating to items that are not on the court's docket (e.g. subpoenas).



Increased Maximum File Size Limit for ECF Documents

The maximum file size for PDF documents that may be uploaded into ECF has been increased from 5MB to 25MB. This will allow for the filing of larger documents without the need to segment a single file into multiple files.
