Each time a **FILER** uses the Court's Electronic Filing System to file a document electronically, they are certifying that (1) they are authorized to file the document(s) by the **FIRM** on whose behalf the document is being filed, (2) the **FIRM** is the same entity stated on that **FILERS** application to use the ECF system and (3) the individual whose signature appears on the original document(s) has authorized the filing of that document.
- 4. The use of the login and password constitutes the signature of **FIRM**. The name of the person filing the document should be typed on the signature line.
- 5. **FILERS** shall serve any document filed electronically in accordance with the applicable rules.
