Bankruptcy Reform Act Information Bulletin No. 5

Changes in Statutory and Miscellaneous Bankruptcy Fees Effective October 17, 2005

Changes to the statutory and miscellaneous bankruptcy fees will take effect October 17, 2005, as a result of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005, Pub. L. No. 109-8.

The statutory filing fee amounts required by 28 U.S.C. § 1930 will change as follows:

REOPENING FEES (28 U.S.C. § 1930(b)

The fee charged for reopening a case would be the amount of the filing fee for the appropriate chapter of the particular case on the date of reopening. After October 17, 2005, the fee for reopening a Chapter 7 case is \$220, the fee for reopening a Chapter 11 case is \$1,000, and the fee for reopening a Chapter 13 case is \$150.

SPLIT CASES

Pursuant to Item 19 for the Bankruptcy Miscellaneous Fee Schedule, the fee charged for splitting a case would be equal to the filing fee, at the time of the request to split the cases, for the chapter under which the joint case was commenced. After October 17, 2005, the fee for splitting a Chapter 7 case is \$220.00, the fee for splitting a Chapter 13 case is \$150.00, and the fee for splitting a Chapter 11 case is \$1,000.
