**Changes to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure  
And Official Bankruptcy Forms Effective December 1, 2010**

On April 28, 2010, the United States Supreme Court approved changes to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. These changes will become effective **December 1, 2010**, and shall apply to all cases and proceedings commenced thereafter, and, insofar as just and practicable, all proceedings then pending. Please note that N. D. Tex. LBR 1007-1(a) has been changed to comply with the new deadline in Rule 1007(a)(2). See the change noted in **red** below.

***L.B.R. 1007-1 Lists, Schedules & Statements.***

**(a) Mailing List.**

A mailing list containing the name and address of each entity included or to be included on Schedules D, E, F, G and H shall be filed contemporaneously with every voluntary petition and within ~~2~~ **(7)** days of the entry of an order for relief in an involuntary case. The mailing list shall be submitted in accordance with the Court's Administrative Procedures for Electronic Filing, and shall include those agencies and offices of the United States required to receive notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002(j). The mailing list shall be filed by the debtor or party responsible for filing the schedules and statements of affairs. Failure to file the mailing list as prescribed in this rule is cause for summary dismissal of the case.
