By Special Order 2002-01, the Bankruptcy Judges of this Court adopted amendments to the Local Bankruptcy Rules. These amendments amended Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005.4 and adopted new Local Bankruptcy Rules 7005.1 and 9036.1.

The deadline for public comment expired on June 1, 2002. There being no public comment or modification by the Court, these rules shall take effect on September 1, 2002, and shall apply to all cases and proceedings thereafter commenced under the Court's Electronic Filing System, and insofar as applicable to noticing and service by the clerk of the bankruptcy court, all cases and proceedings then pending.

L.B.R. 5005.4 Electronic Filing and Noticing.

Electronic Filing and Noticing Authorized ~~Subject to Court Approval~~. The clerk of the bankruptcy court is authorized to implement methods for electronic filing and noticing accept documents for filing, issue notices and serve orders and judgments electronically, and to specify practices in electronic case management, subject to the approval of the court. The clerk shall give notice to the bar when implementing methods of electronic filing and noticing procedures approved by the court and consistent with technical standards, if any, that the Judicial Conference of the United States establishes.

L.B.R. 7005.1 Service by Electronic Means.

Service Through Court Transmission Facilities Authorized. Subject to the administrative procedures approved by the court and consistent with technical standards, if any, that the Judicial Conference of the United States establishes, parties are authorized to make service under Rule 5(b)(2)(D) through the court’s transmission facilities.

L.B.R. 9036.1 Electronic Service.

Service Through Court Transmission Facilities Authorized. Subject to the administrative procedures approved by the court and consistent with technical standards, if any, that the Judicial Conference of the United States establishes, parties are authorized to make service under Rule 9036 through the court’s transmission facilities.
