CM/ECF Changes & Updates

This section includes information regarding changes and updates to CM/ECF events, menus and the way the system processes information.

Notice of Additional Fees and Rule 2016 Disclosure

The event **Bankruptcy > Notice > Notice of Additional Fees and Rule 2016 Disclosure** has been created. Provided the Debtor agrees and there is no objection by any other party, and notwithstanding any other provision of this General Order, for certain matters not included in the Standard Fee or the Business Standard Fee, and to encourage uniformity and consistency and to minimize the expense of the fee application process, the Court will approve the Additional Fees described herein upon the filing of a **Notice of Additional Fees and Rule 2016 Disclosure**. Parties in interest will have 14 days from the date of the service of such Notice to file and serve and objection to same. If no timely objection is received, the Additional Fees set out in the Notice may be deemed allowed and payment may be made directly by the Debtor or through the confirmed Plan as set out in the Notice.

Notice by Trustee of Increased Plan Base, Plan Term and/or Plan Payments

The event **Bankruptcy > Trustee/US Trustee > Notice by Trustee of Increased Plan Base, Plan Term and/or Plan Payments** has been created. The notice filed and sent by the Trustee to the Debtor and Debtor's counsel notifying the Debtor of a change in the Base Amount, Plan Payment, or term of the Plan in order to cure an insufficiency in the Plan as a result of an increase in the amount of attorney's fees to be disbursed by the Trustee, as set out in Paragraphs 21 and 22 of <u>General</u> <u>Order 2021-01</u>.
