



This guide contains information regarding changes to CM/ECF events and procedures.

The Supreme Court adopted changes to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the Official Bankruptcy forms, which are scheduled to take effect on December 1, 2025. These changes require modifications to the court's bankruptcy rules, forms, dictionary events, and deadlines.

Overview

Effective December 1, 2025, Bankruptcy Rule 3002.1 is being amended to apply more broadly to allow assessments of a mortgage claim's status while a chapter 13 case is pending. Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 8006 is also being amended to clarify that any party, not just the appellant, may request direct appellate review.

Amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure

AMENDED FEDERAL RULES

Bankruptcy Rule 3002.1

Bankruptcy Rule 3002.1 is being amended to apply more broadly and encourage a greater degree of compliance with its provisions and allow assessments of a mortgage claim's status while a chapter 13 case is pending in order to give the debtor an opportunity to cure any post-petition defaults that may have occurred.

Bankruptcy Rule 8006

Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 8006 has been revised to clarify that **any party** to a bankruptcy appeal—not just the appellant—**may file a request for the court of appeals to authorize a direct appeal**. The amendments also update subdivision (g) to provide greater procedural clarity regarding the steps for seeking direct review under 28 U.S.C. § 158(d)(2).

New Events and Form Changes

New Events

Motion Under Rule 3002.1(f)(1) to Determine the Status of the Mortgage Claim

Form 410C13-M1

The event "**Bankruptcy > Motions/Applications > Motion to Determine Status of Mortgage Claim Under 3002.1(f)(1)**" corresponds with **Form 410C13-M1**, which is used to file a motion under Rule 3002.1(f)(1) to determine the status of a mortgage claim in a bankruptcy case. The Trustee or Debtor may initiate this review at any stage of the case. The purpose of this review is to identify and resolve any accounting issues prior to case closure.

Response to Motion Under Rule 3002.1(f)(1) to Determine the Status of the Mortgage Claim

Form 410C13-M1R

The event "**Bankruptcy > Claims Actions > Response to Motion to Determine Status of Mortgage Claim Under 3002.1(f)(1)**" corresponds with **Form 410C13-M1R**, which is used by a mortgage creditor to file a response to a motion under Rule 3002.1(f)(1) regarding the status of the mortgage claim. The claimant must file this response within 28 days of the motion being filed.

Trustee's Notice of Disbursements Made

Form 410C13-N

The event "**Bankruptcy > Trustee/US Trustee > Trustee's Notice of Disbursements Made**" corresponds with **Form 410C13-N**. At the end of the case, the Trustee is required to file a Notice of Disbursements Made specifying, among other things, the amount paid to cure any default on the claim and stating whether the default has been fully cured.

Response to Trustee's Notice of Disbursements Made

Form 410C13-NR

The event "**Bankruptcy > Claims Actions > Response to Trustee's Notice of Disbursements Made**" corresponds with **Form 410C13-NR**, which is used to file a response to the Trustee's Notice of Disbursements Made. This form is required to be filed as a supplement to the claim holder's proof of claim.

Motion Under Rule 3002.1(g)(4) to Determine Final Cure and Payment of Mortgage Claim

Form 410C13-M2

The event "**Bankruptcy > Motions/Applications > Motion Under Rule 3002.1(g)(4) to Determine Final Cure and Payment of Mortgage Claim**" corresponds with **Form 410C13-M2**, which is used to file a motion under Rule 3002.1(g)(4) to determine whether the mortgage claim has been fully cured and if all payments have been completed.

Response to Motion Under Rule 3002.1(g)(4) to Determine Final Cure and Payment of the Mortgage Claim

Form 410C13-M2R

The event "**Bankruptcy > Claims Actions > Response to Motion to Determine Final Cure and Mortgage Payment Under 3002.1(g)(4)**" corresponds with **Form 410C13-M2R**, which is used to file a response to a motion filed by the Trustee or Debtor under Rule 3002.1(g)(4) regarding the final cure and payment of the mortgage claim.
