Withdrawal of Notice of Post-Petition Mortgage Fees

The event [**Bankruptcy > Claim Actions > Withdrawal of Notice of Post Petition Mortgage Fees**] has been created. This event will work similarly to the event "Withdrawal of Notice of Mortgage Payment Change" and will be visible on the claims register. (see Figure 1).

Response to Notice of Amount Deemed Necessary to Cure

A new event [**Bankruptcy > Claim Actions > Response to Notice of Amount Deemed Necessary to Cure**] has been created. This was created for creditors to use since they do not have access to the "Response/Objection/Reply to Response" menu in ECF. Creditors should no longer use the "Response to Notice of Final Cure Payment Rule 3002.1" event to file a response to the Trustee's "Notice of Amount Deemed Necessary to Cure". **Non-creditor** filers can continue to use the "Response/Objection/Reply to Response" event from the Bankruptcy menu in ECF. (see Figure 2)
