PROCEDURAL UPDATES

SEALED DOCUMENTS

When a sealed document is filed, a copy of the document must now be provided to the Court in .PDF format on an electronic media storage device (CD, flash drive, diskette, etc.). The media storage device must be placed in a sealed envelope.

The Order Regarding Sealed Documents has been modified to allow the filing party sixty (60) days to retrieve the sealed document(s). If the filing party does not retrieve the sealed document(s) or respond to the order within 60 days, the Court will unseal and docket the documents.

CM/ECF UPDATES AND CHANGES

INTERVENOR COMPLAINT

The **Intervenor complaint** event now allows you to specify that you are amending a previously filed intervenor complaint (see fig. 1).



MOTION TO DISMISS ADVERSARY PROCEEDING

A warning message has been added to the Motion to Dismiss adversary proceeding event (see fig. 2).



To motion the Court for the dismissal of a party from an adversary proceeding, you must use the **Motion to Dismiss party** event (see fig. 3)



WHO WILL THIS CHANGE AFFECT? CM/ECF users seeking to dismiss an adversary proceeding or a single party from an adversary proceeding

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ABANDON

The **Notice of intent to abandon** event has been added to the list of available notice events (see fig. 4). Previously, this event was only available to Trustee filers. Now, attorneys representing the Trustee may also use this event.



LIST (EXHIBIT/WITNESS/GENERIC) LINKAGE

The **List (exhibit/witness/generic)** event has been modified and now allows a user to link to an order on a motion to show cause (see fig. 5).



TIPS & TRICKS

NOTICE OF APPEAL

A warning message has been added to the **Notice of Appeal** event (see fig. 6). A notice of appeal may not be filed if the order, judgment or decree has not yet been entered.

Warning! Only link this notice of appeal to one final judgment, order, or decree of a bankruptcy Judge.
Do NOT docket this event if the order, judgment, or decree has NOT YET been entered [Next] Clear

FILE NEW BANKRUPTCY CASE

A warning message has been added to the File New Bankruptcy Case event (see fig. 7).

Please ensure when adding debtor and/or joint debtors to the case that		
1 - party names match EXACTLY as shown on the petition.		
2 - the mailing address is entered, NOT the street address		
Also note: Input a phone number for the debtor.

When a new petition is filed, you must enter the mailing address for the debtor, to ensure that notices can be properly served.

JOINT CERTIFICATION TO COURT OF APPEALS

A warning message has been added to the Joint certification to court of appeals event (see fig. 8)

To file a Certification to the Court of Appeals (<u>not</u> a Joint Certification), you must use the **Certification to Court of Appeals** motion event (see fig. 9)



A warning message has been added to the **Notice (generic)** (see fig. 10) and **Notice generic (batch)** (see fig. 11) events.


