Final Report and Account of Assets (batch), Chapter 12/13 Trustee's Final Report and Account

The events [Bankruptcy > Trustee/US Trustee > Final Report and Account of Assets (batch), Chapter 12/13 Trustee's Final Report and Account] have been modified to prevent docketing in certain situations. Docketing will be prevented if the debtor (and joint debtor) has not been dismissed, discharged or terminated. Docketing will still be available in split cases, converted cases or cases that have been transferred out. (see Figure 2)
