
CM/ECF Changes & Updates

Motion for Sanctions

The event **Bankruptcy > Motions/Applications > Sanctions** has been modified. The filer now has the option to select 'Other' when asked "what type of sanction?" If 'Other', enter a description for the type of sanction being requested.

What type of sanction?

- for violation of automatic stay 11 USC 362
- for violation of the discharge injunction 11 USC 524
- for debtor attorney misconduct under Rule 9011
- under Title 28 Sec 1927 counsel liability for excessive costs
