Lisa L. Lambert

Lisa Lambert has been the Assistant United States Trustee in the United States Trustee's Dallas Office since March of 2012. She previously served as an Assistant United States Trustee in Brooklyn, an Acting Assistant U.S. Trustee in Central Islip, New York, and as a trial attorney in Dallas, New York City, and Tyler.

The United States Trustee Program has selected Lisa to serve on several national initiatives related to consumer bankruptcy cases. Since 2008, she has been one of the leaders in the United States Trustee Program's mortgage servicing compliance efforts, and these efforts culminated in a series of national settlements. She has also represented United States Trustees in business reorganization proceedings such as Wyly, Life Partners, Texas Rangers Baseball Partners, Pilgrim's Pride, Bayou Group, and Enron.

Before joining the Office of the United States Trustee, Lisa was a briefing attorney for the Honorable C. Houston Abel, a bankruptcy judge in the Eastern District of Texas, and an associate attorney with John Flowers, a retired bankruptcy judge whose private practice focused on bankruptcy appellate and commercial issues. She obtained her doctor of jurisprudence from Texas Tech School of Law and her undergraduate degree from the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill.

She has participated as a speaker, panelist, or author for bankruptcy continuing legal education seminars sponsored by the Federal Bar Association's Bankruptcy Section, the American Bankruptcy Institute, the State Bar of Texas, and the University of Texas. She teaches bankruptcy advocacy at the Department of Justice's National Advocacy Center, and every year she eagerly anticipates being one of the Texas Tech Duberstein moot court team coaches.
