**GENERAL ORDER 2008-01**

**ORDER VACATING GENERAL ORDERS 2005-04 AND 2006-07**

When the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the "Act") was enacted into law, this court adopted Interim Bankruptcy Rules approved by the Judicial Conference in General Orders 2005-04 and 2006-07.

New rules and amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will take effect on December 1, 2008, unless Congress acts to the contrary, and will supersede the Interim Bankruptcy Rules adopted by the Court with the exception of Interim Rule 5012 (Communication of and Cooperation with Foreign Courts and Foreign Representatives). Accordingly, General Orders 2005-04 and 2006-07 are vacated as of December 1, 2008.
