GENERAL ORDER 2021-07

To provide an equitable distribution of the caseload in the Northern District of Texas, all Chapter 11 cases filed with estimated assets or liabilities of more than \$50 million will be assigned in rotating order to each judge in the division in which the case is filed, with any affiliated cases assigned to the same judge. All other cases will be assigned by random draw as follows:
