STANDING ORDER NO.: 2000-2

On January 20, 2000 the Honorable Robert C. McGuire, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Northern District of Texas, entered Standing Order No.2000-1.3 assigning forty (40%) of the cases filed in the Fort Worth Division to the Honorable Barbara J. Houser.

It shall be the Standing Order in the Fort Worth Division of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas that the following govern all cases assigned to the Honorable Barbara J. Houser on or after April 3, 2000:

1. All petitions and other related documents shall indicate the specific judge assignment by alpha letters in the case number. For example case number 00-42828-BJH-7 is assigned to Judge Barbara J.Houser. Case number 00-42829-MT-7 is assigned to Judge Massie Tillman.
2. All petitions and other documents relating to bankruptcy cases assigned to Judge Barbara J. Houser in the Fort Worth Division of this court shall be filed in the U.S. Bankruptcy Clerk's Office, 501 West 10th St., Fort Worth, TX 76102.
3. An original and two (2) copies of all documents relating to bankruptcy cases assigned to Judge Barbara J. Houser are required for all documents filed subsequent to the petition.
4. Files for bankruptcy cases set for hearing before Judge Barbara J. Houser will not be available to the public for viewing approximately seven (7) days prior to the scheduled hearing.

The procedures in this order shall be effective immediately and will remain in effect until further order of this court.
