Effective February 1, 2001, all newly filed or converted Chapter 11 cases in the Fort Worth Division will be assigned to Barbara J. Houser; and all newly filed or converted Chapter 7 and 13 cases in the Dallas Division will be assigned by random draw as follows:


Robert C. McGuire	33 $\frac{1}{3}$ %
Steven A. Felsenthal	33 $\frac{1}{3}$ %
Harold C. Abramson	33 $\frac{1}{3}$ %

Effective March 1, 2001, all newly filed cases in all chapters in the Fort Worth Division will be assigned to Barbara J. Houser; and all of Judge Houser's pending Chapter 7 and 13 cases in the Dallas Division will be transferred and assigned by random draw as follows:

Steven A. Felsenthal	50%
Harold C. Abramson	50%

In both divisions, pending adversary proceedings will be reassigned with associated bankruptcy cases. This Order does not effect the random distribution of newly filed Chapter 11 cases in the Dallas Division as defined in Standing Order 2000-1. All pending Chapter 11 cases in the Dallas Division will not be reassigned.
